Welcome to Wilson Reading! During the school year students are identified as having difficulty with encoding (spelling) and decoding (reading) skills. Wilson is a program that directly teaches the structure of words in a systematic manner. Lessons are developed to introduce concepts and are also interactive with direct teacher-student instruction throughout the class period. This approach helps teach students to read, write and comprehend text successfully.

Instruction focuses on each students individual needs and provides mastery within each level so that the student is met with success. During class time students are given the opportunity to experience letter sounds, words and written text in a hands-on, multi-sensory approach. Every session follows the eight part lesson that is listed in the left column.

When students begin the Wilson Reading program they have a binder and spiral notebook. Throughout their time in the program the materials travel with them. Notebooks include rules in sounds, spelling and syllables. Also, students have created their own glossary of words learned with pictures and sentences that relate to the meaning. This gives the students a sense of ownership and accomplishment.
